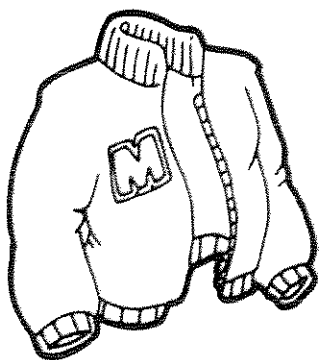
It's that time of year...

through the Winter Wraps distribution and your generosity.

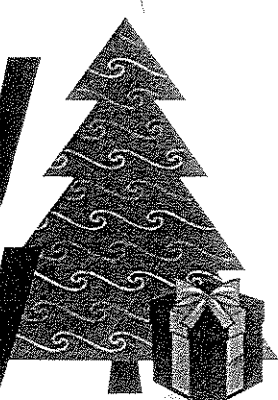

- Picture ID (i.e. Drivers License, State ID, Passport)
- Proof of Kenosha County Residency (i.e. utility bill)
- Your Social Security Card/Number, ITIN Numbers, or case number if you receive FoodShare or BadgerCare
- Children's Social Security Cards or ITIN Numbers
- Names & Social Security or ITIN Numbers of all individuals living in the home (*the total number of household members must equal the number of individuals listed on registration form*)
- Income amount
